Application timing postemergence	Embed Extra (per acre)	Directions
Annual and biennial broadleaf weeds	1 – 2 pts	Apply to annual weeds when small and actively growing
Perennial broadleaf weeds	up to 4 pts	Apply to perennial weeds from bud to bloom stage

### **Citrus restrictions**

- **Preharvest interval:** Do not make applications within 7 days of harvest
- Apply only to groves that have been established for at least one year
- Avoid irrigating trees directly before or after application
- Do not make aerial application of this product in citrus orchards
- Do not apply at wind speeds greater than 15 mph
